*All students enrolled in full year programs will be expected to participate in our annual Recitals. Any dancer who does not wish to participate in the recitals must give written notice to the director by **February 1st** or will be held responsible for the full purchase price of their costume.*

WHEN IS THE SHOW?

*In order to accommodate seating requirements for family and friends we will be holding four recitals this year. They will be held on Friday June 1st, Saturday June 2nd & Sunday June 3rd at **Kennebecasis Valley High School**.*

*Dancers ages 3to8 will perform in **both** Matinee shows on **Saturday June 2nd & Sunday June 3rd** and will **not** participate in the evening performances.*

*All other students will perform in **both** evening shows on **Friday June 1st & Saturday June 2nd**.*

Please Note: *Dancers who attend ages 7 to 10 classes will take part in **both** matinees and will not perform in the evening recitals*

*If, for any reason, your child will not be participating, please inform your instructor by **February 1st**. It is very important for teachers to know exactly who will be performing in order to properly plan costumes and choreography. If your child will not be taking part in the shows, they may continue to attend until the last regular scheduled class, however, they may not attend the dress rehearsal.*

COSTUMES & COSTS

*All costumes are selected by "The Studio" and are based on choreography, function, age appropriateness and price. We make every effort to keep your costs to a minimum. **You may be responsible for hemming or minor alterations.***

*Costume deposits were paid by most students upon registration. The balance of your costume payment will be due by the end of **February**.*
